
Please connect an Ethernet cable from your existing modem/router/network in to the port labelled "**Internet**" on the back of the Netgear.



Please connect an Ethernet cable between port 1 on the back of the Netgear and your computer.

Turn on the router and wait for a few minutes.

Open a web browser and type `http://192.168.1.1` in to the address bar.

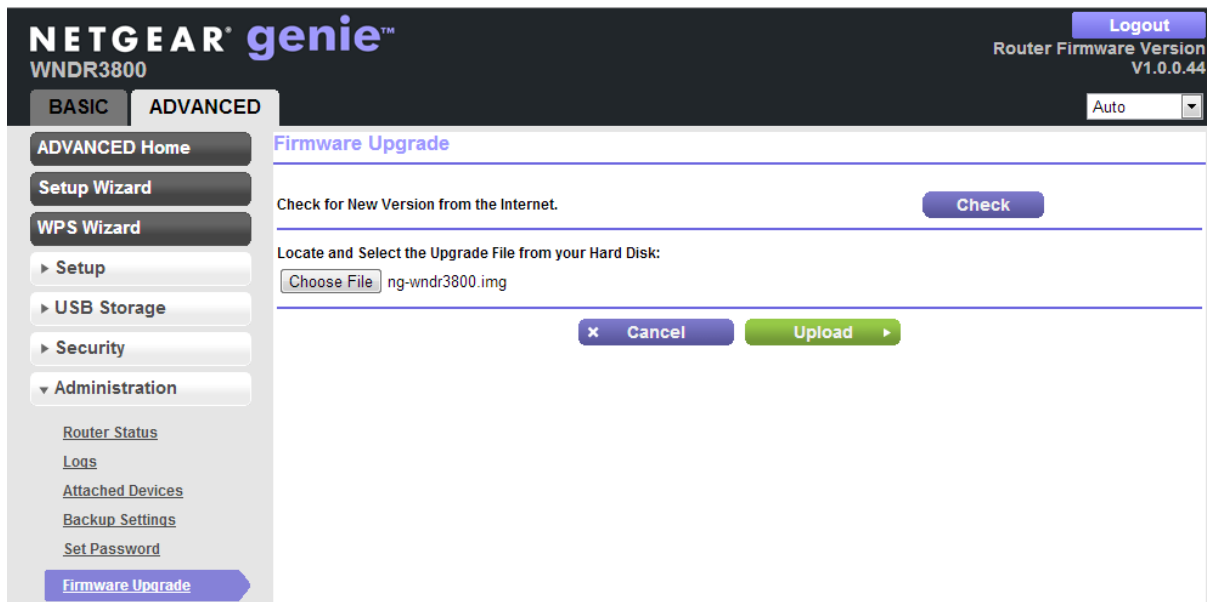
The server `http://192.168.1.1:80` requires a username and password. The server says: NETGEAR WNDR3800.

You will be prompted to log-in. The default username is "**admin**" and the password is "**password**" unless you have changed these.

Click on "**Advanced**" on the top menu.



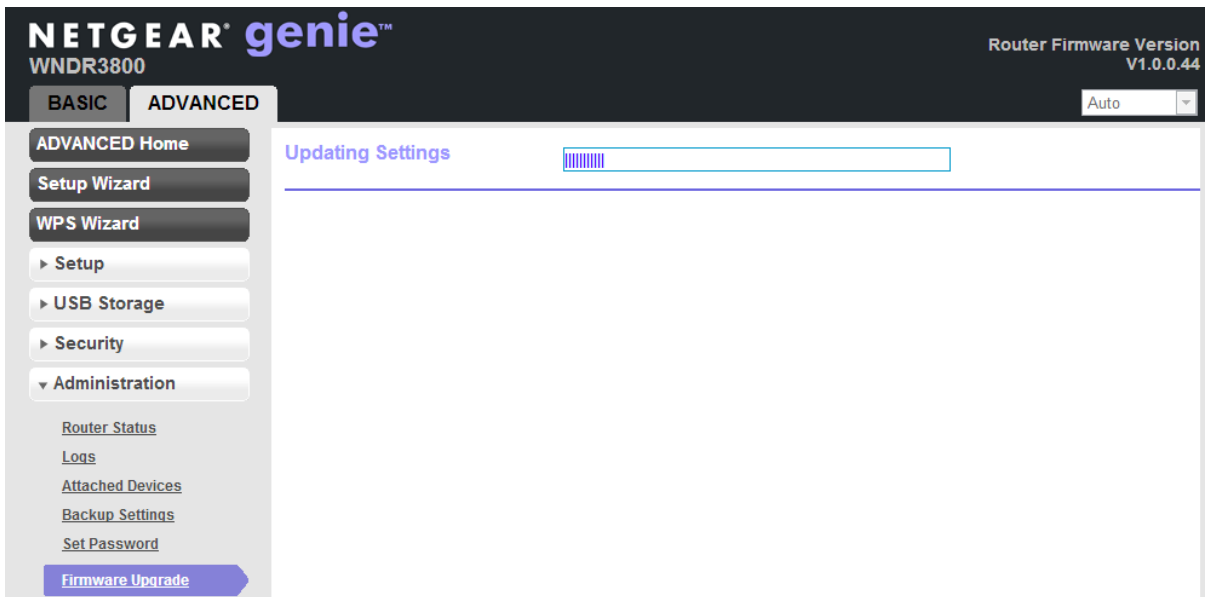
Click "**Administration**" on the left menu.

Click "**Firmware Upgrade**" on the left.

Click "**Choose File**" and browse to the firmware file that you have been provided.

**NOTE:** If you receive an error, please rename the file extension to .img instead of .bin. So the full file name will be ng-wndr3800.img and try uploading again.

Click "**Yes**" to confirm the firmware upgrade.



The upgrade process will now begin. This takes up to 5 minutes to complete.
