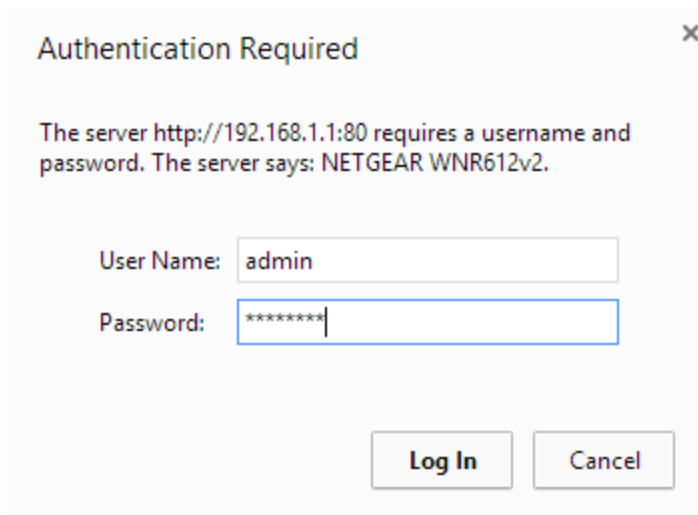

Please connect an Ethernet cable from your existing modem/router/network in to the blue port on the back of the Netgear

Please connect an Ethernet cable between yellow port 1 on the back of the Netgear and your computer.

Turn on the router and wait for a few minutes.

Open a web browser and type `http://192.168.1.1` in to the address bar.

The server `http://192.168.1.1:80` requires a username and password. The server says: NETGEAR WNR612v2.

You will be prompted to log-in. The default username is "**admin**" and the password is "**password**" unless you have changed these.

Click on "**Router Upgrade**" on the left menu.

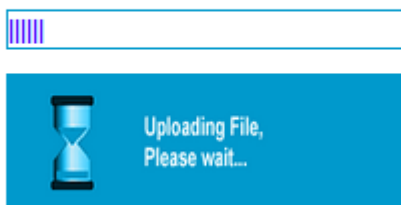
Click "**Browse**" and browse to the firmware file that you have been provided.

Click "**Upload**" to confirm the firmware upgrade.

NOTE: If you have an error stating the file is not recognised, please rename the downloaded firmware file to "**wnr612v2-V1.0.0_31.0.5.img**" and try again.

Note: It will take about 3 minutes for firmware upgrade.

Please don't turn off the power or press reset button.



The upgrade process will now begin. This takes up to 5 minutes to complete.
